PAYMENT

Full non-refundable deposit must accompany this application. The applicant agrees to pay all fees under the conditions of this application. Registration fees and tuition fees, paid or outstanding, are non-refundable after dates outlined on individual tuition plan details, even in the event of absence, withdrawal, or dismissal from the program. Tuition must be paid in full before the student can receive a place in the program. If the student wishes to withdraw from the program at a later date, she/he/they may do so but shall receive no reimbursement.

Tuition includes all seminar classes on Paros, Greece, as well as orientation/farewell dinners, Acropolis Tour and Tickets, Traditional Greek Dancing and Ancient Greek Theatre Workshops in Athens, Metro tickets to Rallou Manou studio, and Charter Bus from Athens, Greece to Piraeus Port, Greece. Students will be responsible for any additional recreational activities of choice on Paros or in Athens. Tuition does NOT cover additional travel and social activities, ferries, housing, food, local transportation, and travel to/from Greece.

BEHAVIOR

In the event that a student behaves in a disruptive or inappropriate fashion in a classroom or workshop session, the student shall receive a warning from the program director. In the event that the behavior continues or if a second warning is issued, the student shall be dismissed from the program, at the expense of the student/family, and no refund shall be offered. All students are expected to participate in all daily seminar classes and workshops unless medically excused from an activity.

- Resume of relevant theatre experience. (You may include work resumes as well, but it is not necessary.)

- A video that you feel showcases who you are as a performer. This may include but is not limited to a production or showcase video in which the applicant is clearly identified and featured, a video of two contrasting pieces (monologues, songs, dance, musical instruments), filmed scene work or footage from film work. Please identify in cover letter which actor is the applicant if multiple persons appear on screen!

THEATRICAL PREPARATION

Students will be given supplemental material to prepare and familiarize themselves with for individual classes after the March 1, 2020 admission cut-off. All participants will be expected to have proper dance shoes and clothing that will permit both movement and dance. More information to follow.

RECORDING & PHOTOGRAPHY RELEASE
